Inner City Capital Connections (ICCC) is a tuition-free program designed by the Initiative for a Competitive Inner City (ICIC) to help small business owners in under-resourced communities build capacity and resiliency for long-term sustainable growth, as well as navigate the continued impact of the COVID-19 pandemic.

We know that the small business community, particularly those in underserved communities, has been hit the hardest by the pandemic. Now, more than ever, they need access to capital, one-on-one coaching, and capacity-building education, fundamental components of the ICCC program.

WHO WE SERVE

We recruit businesses with the following qualifications to participate in ICCC:

- Be an independent, for-profit or non-profit corporation, partnership or proprietorship.
- Have its headquarters or more than 51% of its physical operations located in an economically-distressed area OR have more than 40% of employees residing in an economically-distressed area.
- Have revenues for the past three years, and a minimum of \$150,000 in at least one of those years;
- Have been in operation for three years or more and must be past the proof-of-concept stage. ICCC does not accept start-up companies.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The ICCC program is comprised of four key components with a time commitment of 40 hours spread over a 5-month period.



OPENING SEMINAR

The ICCC program begins with an interactive virtual two-day seminar series that focuses on actionable business recovery strategies and provides essential information on available capital and technical assistance resources.



COACHING

Participants receive one-on-one general business and capital coaching to tackle specific challenges, navigate uncertainty, and prepare to access much-needed capital.



DIGITAL LEARNING

The digital learning series incorporates webinars and online learning modules designed to deepen the learnings from the Opening Seminar with both actionable resources and personalized education.



ANNUAL CONFERENCE

The culminating conference ties together all the program components, and participants exit the program with the tools to access immediate capital solutions, a vibrant network, and an effective strategy for their business to survive, recover and grow.

OUR IMPACT

Since 2005, ICCC has helped over 5,000 businesses access \$2.35 billion in capital and create 23,674 jobs in their communities. In 2021, we served 1,212 businesses in 21 markets, with 81% identifying as BIPOC-owned and 54% as womenowned businesses.
